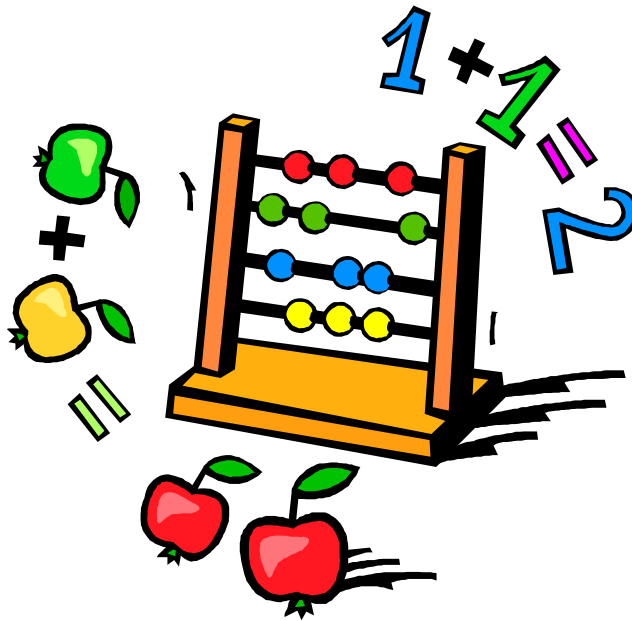

How to Register for Friday School

1) Read the Welcome Pages of this Booklet Thoroughly.

The information listed here is vital for Friday School to function properly.

2) Fill Out Class Request Form Completely.

Make sure you write in as many choices as possible for each child, per hour. We will attempt to place your children in their first choice; however, if that class is full, we will move to the 2nd choice. If you do not list your alternative choices, the processing of your child's registration could be delayed.

Do not write in any areas that have to do with fees or totals.

The registration team will calculate your totals.

Remember to register each of your children, including those in the nursery, who will be at Friday School each Friday.

3) Turn in Your Request Form

Registration Day will be announced prior to each session

You must be there at the appointed time to receive priority.*

Numbers available at 9:00am

General 2:00 pm - 4:00 pm

You will not be issued a number until the listed time.

Numbers available at 1:00pm

Your \$20.00 (\$10.00 if joining in January) Registration Fee is due on this day.

Your FCHM Membership Dues will need to be paid online *prior* to this day.

If you are bringing in a registration form for someone else, please pick a number for them also!

Class request forms will be processed on a first come first served basis, with Friday School leaders' and teachers' children having priority.*

A Friday School representative will be at New Life to collect your form and answer any questions you may have.
Please do not turn any forms into the church office.

4) Orientation & Pay Day (to be announced prior to session)

All class fees need to be paid this day.

A \$10.00 late fee will be assessed for payments after this date.

We will be having a potluck so families can fellowship together and new families can tour the building.

5) Changes in class choices are discouraged.

To emphasize this, a \$10.00 fee *per change* will be assessed after **registration day**.

No class changes may be made without prior authorization by the Friday School Coordinator.

6) Parents: You must help in at least 2 of the 3 hours.

You may have 1 hour off for fellowship if you are not needed elsewhere.

If you are not a teacher, you will be considered a floater for your hour off.

This simply means you will need to help in a class if needed.
